THE 6TH EDITION OF TANGIER LOGISTICS DAYS UNDER THE THEME "SUPPLY CHAINS FACING MAJOR GEOPOLITICAL AND ENVIRONMENTAL CHALLENGES"



The 6th edition of Tanger Logistics Days (TLD) was held on September 27th at Tanger Med Port Center, under the theme "Supply chains facing major geopolitical and environmental challenges". This event brought together more than 400 participants from the port and logistics sector, in Morocco and internationally, offering a space for exchanges and reflection on the future of supply chains in a global context in constant evolution.

The program brought together leading experts to analyze current trends and challenges in supply chains. The morning focused on the consequences of the break in globalization, followed by a panel focused on geopolitical and environmental challenges. Speakers shared their views on the sustainable management of logistics infrastructures and the impact of international

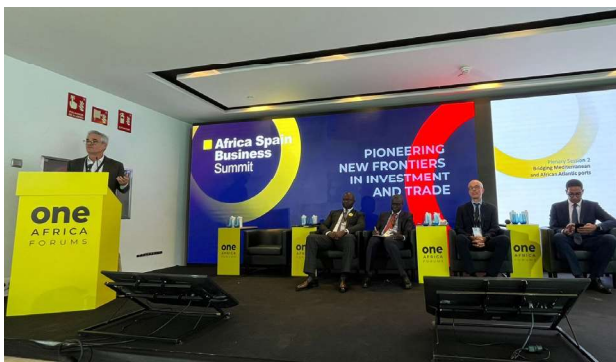
tensions on trade flows. The afternoon was devoted to the impact of emerging technologies, such as artificial intelligence, 5G, and humanoids, on supply chain management. A panel explored the conditions necessary for integrating these innovations into logistics operations. The day concluded with a discussion on resilience strategies and risk management in an increasingly uncertain environment.

Tanger Logistics Days, organized by Tanger Med Group, are technical meetings dedicated to the exploration of key themes in the transport and logistics sector. They demonstrate the Group's commitment to promote enriching exchanges and to enlighten professionals on current and future challenges, therefore contributing to the development of sustainable and resilient logistics.

PARTICIPATION IN THE AFRICA SPAIN BUSINESS SUMMIT (ASBS)



Tanger Med Group participated in the Africa Spain Business Summit (ASBS), which took place in Barcelona from July 9 –11, 2024. This event supports economic relationships between Africa and Spain, offering a high-level exchange platform where decision-makers and key players from both continents meet.

Mr. Rachid HOUARI, Managing Director of Tanger Med Port Logistics Zone, participated in the plenary session entitled "Bridging Mediterranean and African Atlantic Ports". This intervention highlighted the central role of Mediterranean and Atlantic ports in the development of exchanges between Africa and Europe, thus strengthening the position of Tanger Med as an essential logistics hub in the region.

LYMED ADMISSION RESULTS: A SUCCESSFUL PREPARATION



After two years of hard work and intense preparation, our students saw their efforts rewarded by admission to the most prestigious Engineering Schools in France.

As in the previous year, the success rate of our students this year is particularly remarkable. Our preparatory students have once again distinguished themselves by securing a place in the Top 10 engineering schools in Morocco, with the highest admission rate of any CPGE in Morocco.

In fact, three students succeeded in joining the École Polytechnique, six have been admitted to power plants and seventeen to the Mines-Ponts schools.

Among the eight students from the region in this outgoing promotion, one was admitted to the École Polytechnique, three were accepted to Mines-Ponts schools, and three others will join the Écoles Centrale.

This success reflects not only the quality of the education provided within LYMED but also the desire of Tanger Med Group to make the Northern region of Morocco a model of excellence at the national level.

BENIN MANUTENTIONS S.A AND MARSA MAROC CONSOLIDATE THEIR PARTNERSHIP FOR THE MANAGEMENT OF TERMINALS 1 AND 5 AT THE PORT OF COTONOU



On September 24, 2024, Marsa Maroc signed a delegated management agreement with Bénin Manutentions S.A for Terminals 1 and 5 in the Port of Cotonou, as a result of the award of this contract in July 2024, following an international selection process.

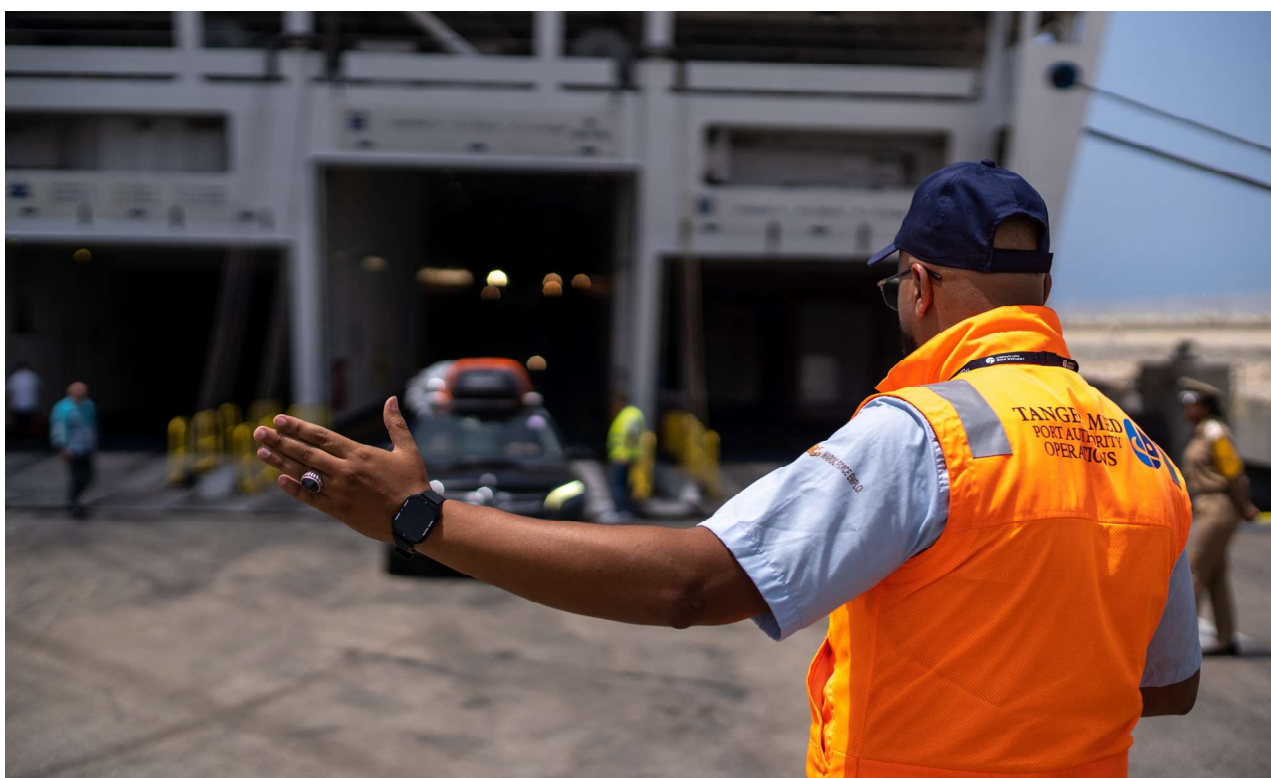
As part of this partnership, focused on operational excellence, Marsa Maroc will support Bénin Manutentions S.A in the start-up and management of port operations. Thanks to its expertise and its relationships with major international shipping companies, Marsa Maroc is committed to positioning Bénin Manutentions S.A as a reference operator, contributing to the development of logistics corridors in the region.

Marsa Maroc will ensure that the commissioning of the Terminals complies with deadlines and international standards, while undertaking several modernization projects in line with the Benin government's vision. This partnership, which is part of the South-South cooperation strategy promoted by the High Royal Guidelines, aims to create value for the entire Benin port ecosystem.

With this agreement, Marsa Maroc reaffirms its ambition to internationalize, in line with its new "Marsa 2030" strategy. The start of operations at Terminal 1 at the port of Cotonou is scheduled for the beginning of October 2024.

Port and Logistics

1 734 160 PASSENGERS AND 457 624 VEHICLES PASSED THROUGH TANGER MED PORT DURING THE MARHABA 2024 CAMPAIGN



The Marhaba campaign launched on June 5th and completed on September 15, 2024 ran smoothly at Tanger Med Port. A total of 1 734 160 Passengers and 457 624 vehicles passed through the port, up by 7% and 11% respectively compared to 2023.

To guarantee access to the port, especially during busy periods, passengers have been advised to bring a confirmed return ticket with them before arrival. This year's event was marked by a fluid and secure flow of passengers, thanks to the total involvement of all partners, notably the local authorities, the DGSN, the Gendarmerie and Customs, under the coordination of the Mohammed V Foundation for Solidarity.

The exemplary cooperation between the Moroccan and Spanish authorities has made it possible to manage flows effectively, especially during periods of high traffic.

SIMULEX-24 EXERCISE: SIMULATING MARINE POLLUTION CONTROL AT TANGER MED



On September 25, 2024, Tanger Med Port Complex hosted the 11th edition of the “SIMULEX-24” simulation exercise, aimed at testing the effectiveness of the National Emergency Plan (PUN) in combatting accidental marine pollution. This large-scale exercise, conducted in collaboration with various ministerial departments, the Royal Armed Forces, and local authorities, mobilized maritime, land, and air resources.

The scenario involved a leak of 3,000 m³ of heavy fuel oil from a tanker off the coast of the Complex. Tanger Med Port, affecting Dalia beach and requiring response operations at sea, on land, and in the port. The exercise provided an opportunity to assess coordination between the various players and raise awareness of the importance of protecting the marine and coastal environment.

OCEAN NETWORK EXPRESS, HMM, AND YANG MING MARINE ANNOUNCE THE CREATION OF PREMIER ALLIANCE

Ocean Network Express (ONE), HMM, and Yang Ming Marine announced their decision to continue their close cooperation under the new name "Premier Alliance", which will take over from "THE Alliance" starting in February 2025.

Premier Alliance will serve a total of 49 ports, including Tanger Med Port Complex. The alliance services will call at the terminal operated by Tanger Alliance, operated by operators ONE, HMM, and Yang Ming.

This new alliance will operate on the main international shipping routes, including:

- Asia - Northern Europe,
- Asia - Middle East,
- Asia - Mediterranean,
- Asia - West coast of North America,
- Asia - East coast of North America.

GEMINI COOPERATION: TANGER MED PORT COMPLEX, A KEY TRANSshipment PLATFORM IN THE MEDITERRANEAN

As part of the GEMINI strategic alliance, Maersk and Hapag Lloyd, respectively the first and second largest shipowners of Tanger Port Complex, will integrate the latter as an essential transshipment platform in their Mediterranean rotations starting in February 2025.

This cooperation will set up an optimized network of maritime services, with particular attention paid to transshipment hubs according to the "hub & spoke" model. This model will be reinforced by an increased capacity for rotations of dedicated feeders, ensuring the connection between the main regional hubs and other entry points, known as "gateways". The main line services of this alliance will call at 56 ports, while 29 other ports will be served by dedicated feeders.

The choice of Tanger Med Port Complex by GEMINI cooperation is explained by the port's leadership position on a global scale in terms of operational performance.

MARSA MAROC

PORT OF AGADIR: MARSA MAROC INCREASES ITS PARTICIPATION



On July 8, 2024, Marsa Maroc announced that it had strengthened its participation in Société de Manutention d'Agadir, in which it now holds 100% of the capital, against 51% previously.

This operation is part of Marsa Maroc's strategy to improve its competitiveness and to offer ever more efficient services to economic operators. By taking total control of the Agadir Handling Company, Marsa Maroc intends to generate operational synergies with the other multi-purpose terminal that it also manages at the port of Agadir, in order to improve the quality of its services for its customers.

PORT OF NADOR: OPERATION MARHABA 2024

As part of the Marhaba 2024 operation, Marsa Maroc mobilized to ensure transit in the best conditions of comfort and safety. The teams at the port of Nador provided Moroccans from around the world with access to reception areas, information desk agents, and sheltered areas. During this period, more than 142 000 cars and 556 000 passengers passed through the port of Nador, testifying to Marsa Maroc's commitment to facilitating this important moment of return for Moroccans living abroad.

PORT OF JORF LASFAR: PROCESSING THE FIRST RAW SUGAR SHIPMENT



On September 3, 2024, Marsa Maroc handled a first shipment of 55,000 tons of raw sugar for its customer COSUMAR, to supply its new refinery in the Doukkala region, with a capacity of 500,000 tons per year.

With an expected rate of two monthly stops, the annual raw sugar traffic at the port of Jorf Lasfar is expected to reach 500,000 tons, generating additional volume to that already managed at the port of Casablanca. This operation marks a strategic partnership between Marsa Maroc and COSUMAR, aimed at strengthening national autonomy in raw sugar and supporting the development of the sugar industry at the regional and national levels.

NEW SET-UPS AT THE LOGISTICS PLATFORM OPERATED BY "MEDHUB"

ARDEVUR



The ARDEVUR Group, specialized in international trade of raw materials, particularly metals and industrial minerals, has established itself in the port logistics zone to offer tailored and comprehensive solutions for import, export, and logistics.

Its expertise in the raw materials sector, combined with a global network of partners and suppliers, will enable ARDEVUR to offer a full range of services that meet the needs of its clients.

LOEXIMMEB

LOEXIMMEB recently settled in the port logistics area to offer its logistics services to its customers in various sectors including the automotive and textile industries.

LOEXIMMEB will focus on planning and coordinating activities related to transport, storage, and distribution throughout the supply chain.

BURPOL



The Turkish group BURPOL, specializing in the production of high-performance plastic raw materials from recycled products, has chosen to set up its logistics hub in the Logistics Zone to serve the automotive industry in Morocco.

Burpol also aims to expand its international development by getting closer to its customers, in particular Tier 1 and Tier 2 suppliers to the automotive sector. This strategic expansion will strengthen Burpol's presence in key markets including Europe.

DIGITIZATION

VISIT BY AN IVORIAN DELEGATION REPRESENTING THE PORT COMMUNITY OF THE PORT OF ABIDJAN



As part of a study and benchmark mission relating to the implementation of a port community system at the port of Abidjan, a multidisciplinary Ivorian delegation was received by the team of the Department of Operations and Information Systems at the Tanger Med Port Complex on September 23 and 24, 2024.

Various topics relating to the management and development of community port systems, as well as to the digitalization of logistics flows, were discussed with the stakeholders concerned, thus allowing an exchange of experience between Tanger Med teams and members of the delegation.

LAUNCH OF THE "BLOCKCHAIN PAYMENT GATEWAY" SERVICE

On Friday, September 27, 2024, the Banque Centrale Populaire (BCP) and Tanger Med Port Authority (TMPA) signed the first contract for the use of the "Blockchain Payment Gateway" platform, which serves the port and logistics ecosystem.

The deal, which coincides with BCP's participation in Tangier Logistics Days, marks the commitment of TMPA and BCP Group to the ongoing development of innovative and efficient payment solutions to serve operators in the port ecosystem. It has also announced the roll-out of the solution to target import, forwarding, and transport customers.

BCP's "Blockchain Payment Gateway" has been successfully integrated into the Tanger Med Blockchain platform, developed for the benefit of the port and logistics ecosystem. The transactions that will be carried out in this manner are characterized by reinforced security, total transparency, and instantaneous payments. This ensures reliable monitoring of transactions, thus minimizing the risks of fraud and errors.

This initiative opens a new era both in the Moroccan port logistics landscape and in the national payment system.

SIGNING OF AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE NATIONAL INTERPROFESSIONAL OFFICE FOR CEREALS AND LEGUMES (OFFICE NATIONAL INTERPROFESSIONNEL DES CÉRÉALES ET DES LÉGUMINEUSES) AND TANGER MED PORT AUTHORITY

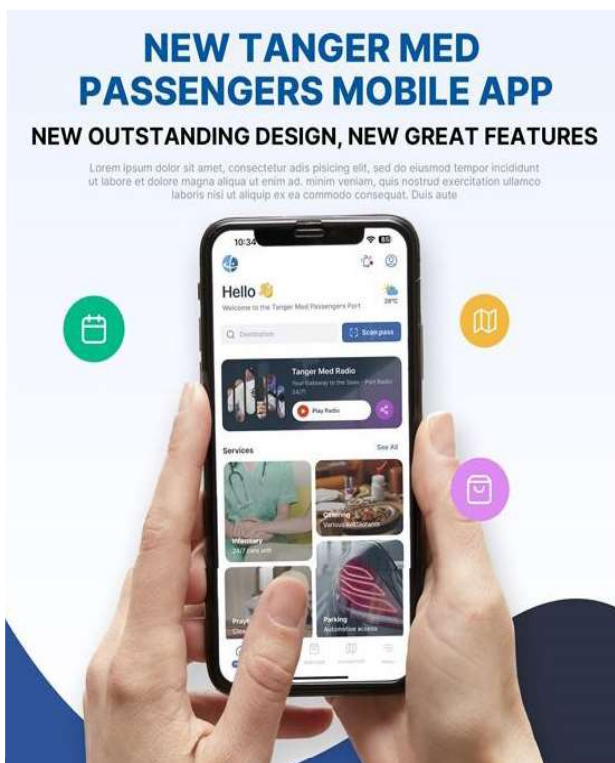
An agreement has been signed between Tanger Med Port Authority (TMPA) and the National Interprofessional Office for Cereals and Legumes (ONICL) to establish a partnership framework aimed at digitizing the procedures for importing and exporting cereals and legumes operations via the Tanger Med Port Community System.

This agreement offers partners an institutional framework to carry out their respective missions, aimed at serving port and logistics communities and international trade through the streamlining, harmonization, simplification, and dematerialization of procedures.

The signing of this agreement is part of the governmental guidelines, also signed on the sidelines of the 6th edition of Tangier Logistics Days, aimed at improving the business climate and strengthening national logistics competitiveness by reducing the costs and deadlines of foreign trade operations.

The commitments made by ONICL and TMPA illustrate the desire of both parties to continuously improve the quality of services offered to importers and exporters of cereals and legumes.

NEW VERSION OF THE PASSENGER MOBILE SOLUTION "TANGER MED PASSENGER JOURNEY"



WEIGHING MANAGEMENT SOLUTION

As part of the pursuit of the digital initiatives of the Tangerang Med Port Authority, a new solution has been put in place to fully digitize the weighing activity.

This new solution retrieves the weighing orders ordered by our customers via the Tangerang Med Port Community System or entered by our agents in the field through the "SI FRET" system. It is also connected to the various weighbridges in the port, allowing the empty and full weights to be automatically recovered. The data collected is then transmitted in real time to the "SI FRET" system, where it can be consulted and shared with all relevant stakeholders, guaranteeing total transparency and optimum traceability of weighing operations.

This new solution represents a major qualitative leap in terms of service quality. Among the many benefits it brings, we can mention the significant reduction of human errors, the saving of valuable time for logistics operations, and the elimination of paper weighing orders, thus aligning with the sustainability strategy adopted by Tangerang Med.

Now available in the Apple Store and Google Play Store, the "Passenger Journey" platform has been specially designed to transform the experience of passengers sending goods through the port complex, by offering a host of high value-added functionalities.

Now available on the App Store and the Play Store, the "Passenger Journey" platform has been specially designed to transform the experience of passengers transiting through the port complex, by offering a multitude of features with high added value. The application also integrates port navigation and guidance tools, allowing passengers to easily locate themselves, discover nearby services, and follow the best routes to complete their boarding procedures. It also offers a towing service to request immediate assistance.

One of the most innovative aspects of this app is the real-time access to port traffic forecasts. This feature allows users to anticipate periods of high traffic and to plan the movement of travelers in a smooth and efficient manner.

The second phase of the project is in preparation and will provide even more services. Future features include the introduction of temporary admission, a claims system, and other essential services to continue optimizing the experience of passengers transiting through Tangerang Med Port.

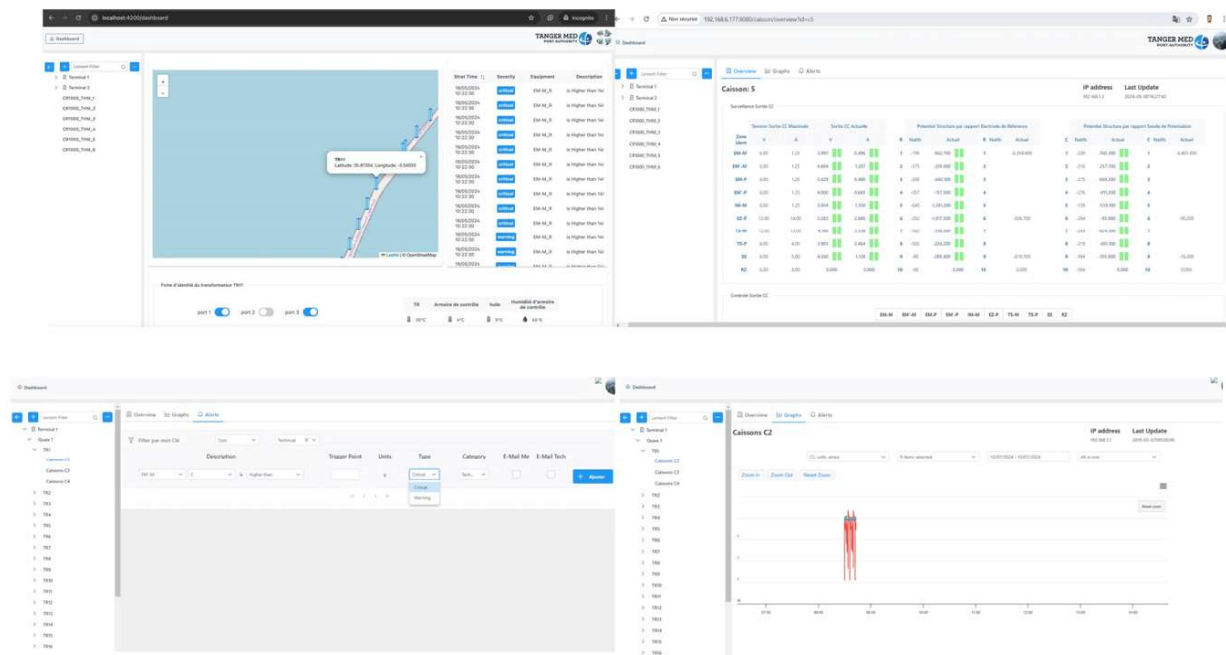
COLLABORATIVE DOCUMENT MANAGEMENT PLATFORM FOR INFRASTRUCTURE AND DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS

As part of the continuous improvement of the coordinated management of infrastructure and development projects at the level of Tangerang Med Port Complex, a document management solution has been implemented to mainly organize:

- Managing validation flows by document type
- Archiving versions of documents
- Notifications

This solution will allow the optimization of the processing times of actions related to document flows, the coordinated management between the various actors of the project, and a better control of the digital archiving of documents.

IMPLEMENTATION OF AN OPERATIONAL DATA CAPTURE SOLUTION “OPERATIONAL TECHNOLOGY”



The OPERATIONAL TECHNOLOGY "OT" solution has been designed and put into production to provide reliable and efficient operational data collection in the field. Initially, it covers the capture of data from the cathodic protection system and the main sealing instrumentation system. Ultimately, this solution will be extended to integrate other port assets, thus consolidating all subsystems and technical data.

The data collected is processed and analyzed in depth to generate usable information. The solution also integrates a prediction layer based on advanced predictive modeling capabilities and on the analysis of historical data. This layer makes it possible to

visualize, notify, and predict potential failures, thus offering increased visibility to maintenance teams and promoting the proactive planning of corrective interventions.

This production launch is part of the port's overall data management strategy, thus strengthening its orientation towards data governance and paving the way for better operational efficiency and optimized preventive maintenance.

FINALIZATION OF THE CIPHER PROJECT: A SUCCESSFUL COLLABORATION BETWEEN THE PORTS OF TANGER MED AND ROTTERDAM



The Cipher Project was finalized in August 2024, marking an important milestone for Tanger Med Port in its collaboration with the Port of Rotterdam. This partnership has made it possible to carry out two innovative pilot projects aimed at digitizing document flows within the supply chain. Thanks to innovative digital solutions and the active participation of key market players, the project significantly reduced delays in container transport and avoided food waste. The solutions implemented in these projects have demonstrated their ability to adapt to other trade routes, thus proving their scalability potential.

The first pilot used a collaborative information-sharing platform, enabling different players in the supply chain (shipper Driscolls, freight forwarder Puerto Transit, and customs clearance agents Partida Logistics and CSI Fresh) to benefit from greater visibility on the status and accuracy of documents, enabling them to detect and correct errors earlier. This approach, based on a "one-stop source for accurate information", has enabled us to reduce documentary errors to zero, avoiding the need to send out more than 2,500 correction emails and preventing food freight losses estimated at €500,000. Ronald Hoekstra, Managing Director of CSI Fresh, explains: "Efficient data processing has been an inexhaustible source of process optimization for us."

The second pilot focused on using Artificial Intelligence to detect errors in documents. The Dutch company Magna Tyres, a tire exporter, tested the Rossum tool, which automatically collects and verifies the consistency of documents. This solution reduced the verification time per shipment by 40 minutes, improving the overall efficiency of the process. Kars van de Sande, Logistics Coordinator at Magna Tyres, says he is impressed by the precision of the tool: "It allows you to check all document fields, even when it comes to bills of lading of various types."

The results of these two pilot projects demonstrated their potential to be applied to other trade routes, thus proving the scalability of these solutions. Tanger Med Port and the Port of Rotterdam are now determined to work towards widespread use of this innovative solution, which will soon be available to the entire port community. This initiative promises to sustainably transform the management of document flows and to strengthen the efficiency of the supply chain.

It's important to emphasize that both of these pilot projects were funded by key market players, who voluntarily wished to support and drive them forward independently because of the significant benefits they bring.

NEW SET-UPS IN TANGER MED'S INDUSTRIAL PLATFORM

TANGER AUTOMOTIVE CITY

EM ENERGIES



EM ENERGIES, a Moroccan business specializing in the manufacture of MV/LV sheaths, tubes, and switchgear, has set up a 10 000 m² facility in Tanger Automotive City. With an investment of 31.5 million MAD, this project will create 155 jobs and strengthen the industrial ecosystem of Tanger Med.

MARCO TECHNOLOGIES



Marco Technologies, a subsidiary of CORELEC Équipements, French leader and international player in the industry, is establishing itself in Tanger Automotive City. Specializing in the manufacture of tanks for the aeronautical surface treatment industry, Marco Technologies has set up operations on a 5 166 m² site, with an investment of 15 million MAD. This project will generate 40 jobs and strengthen TAC's industrial dynamic.

TANGER FREE ZONE

AEW AUTOMOTIVE SYSTEMS MOROCCO



AEW Automotive Systems Morocco, a Chinese company specializing in R&D and the manufacture of automotive accessory parts, has announced plans to set up operations in Tanger Free Zone.

This project will cover an area of 4 200 m² and represents an investment of 27 million MAD. Ultimately, it will generate 181 jobs, thus contributing to the economic dynamism of the region and strengthening the automotive sector in Morocco.

TORNS COLIS



TORNS COLIS, a Spanish company specializing in the manufacture of electrical components, in particular stator coils for high-voltage electric motors, has announced that it will be setting up operations in Tanger Free Zone.

The project covers an area of 3 285 m² and represents an investment of MAD 10 600 000. This new installation will make it possible to create 73 jobs.

CONSERVAS Y SALAZONES

Conservas y Salazones, a leading company in Italy in the processing and conservation of fish, is setting up in Tanger Free Zone on an area of 4 603 m² with an investment of 50 million MAD.

This project promises to generate 450 jobs, thus strengthening the local economy and contributing to the development of the agri-food sector in the region.

EXPANSION PROJECTS AT TANGER MED'S INDUSTRIAL PLATFORM

TANGER AUTOMOTIVE CITY

MARTUR FOMPAK



Martur Fompak International, a leading Turkish manufacturer of automotive interiors and seating, continues to expand in Tanger Automotive City (TAC). With a new surface area of 13 000 m² and an investment of 8 million euros, this project will create 479 jobs. Martur Fompak, using the latest technologies in the sector, is thus strengthening its presence in the Moroccan automotive ecosystem, contributing to the industrial and economic development of the region.

SFC



SFC, a business specializing in the production of sealing components for the automotive industry, is expanding its facilities in Tanger Automotive City. Supplying major customers such as Aston Martin, Renault, and Stellantis, SFC is planning an initial investment of 23 million euros, with a medium-term target of 33 million euros. The expansion will cover an area of 38 500 m², in two phases, creating 150 jobs initially, with a projection of 450 jobs in the medium term.

TÉTOUAN PARK

CONSERVAS SOSASU

Conservas Sosasu, a Moroccan company specializing in the processing of anchovies and the packaging of anchovy-based preserves, is expanding its operations in Tétouan Park to include new packaging operations.

The expansion will cover an area of 2 295 m², bringing the total area to 5 295 m². This investment amounts to 10 million MAD and will allow the creation of 20 new jobs, thus increasing the total to 220 jobs within the company.

PARTICIPATION IN EVENTS AND INTERNATIONAL PRESENCE

PARTICIPATION IN DOING BUSINESS IN THE TANGIER - TÉTOUAN - AL HOCEIMA REGION



On July 11, 2024, the Regional Investment Center (CRI) of Tangier-Tétouan-Al Hoceima organized a new stopover of business and investment promotion meetings, "Doing Business in the Tangier - Tétouan - Al Hoceima region", at the Valence Business School.

Tanger Med Zones participated in this meeting, which is an extension of an ambitious promotion plan started in 2023, which has already seen three stops in Casablanca, Seville, and Barcelona, as well as a digital edition produced in partnership with the Official Chamber of Commerce, Industry, and Services of the province of Badajoz and Extremadura Avante last April.

PARTICIPATION IN THE FARNBOROUGH INTERNATIONAL AERONAUTICAL AND SPACE SHOW



From July 22 to 26, 2024, Tanger Med Zones participated in the Farnborough International Aeronautics and Space Show, a must-see event that connects the aerospace world. This show is recognized for hosting some of the most significant and successful events in this evolving industry.

The Africa Economic Zones Organization (AEZO) participated in the annual GASEZ conference, which took place from September 8-11, 2024 in China, on the sidelines of the China International Investment and Trade Fair (CIFIT), this event brought together key players in sustainable development within Special Economic Zones (SEZs).

The 3rd GASEZ Annual Conference took place in Xiamen and was co-organized by the Global Partnership of Industrial Parks of China (GPIPC) and UN Trade and Development.

THE MARHABA 2024 OPERATION SOLIDARITY EXHIBITION BY TANGER MED FOUNDATION



In partnership with the Cooperation Development Office (ODCO), Tanger Med Foundation organized a community exhibition as part of Operation Marhaba 2024, on the theme "The solidarity economy: a lever for development and social cohesion". This initiative aimed to strengthen the Foundation's commitment to the social economy and income-generating activities.

By organizing this solidarity market, Tanger Med Foundation wanted to capitalize on the significant flows of passengers transiting through Tanger Med Port, to offer a platform for marketing local products from local cooperatives, in particular to Moroccans Living Abroad (MRE).

During the months of July and August, 45 cooperatives, including several from the province of Fahs Anjra, exhibited their local products for the benefit of MREs and visitors to the port community, thus strengthening their visibility and their capacity for development.

DALIA 2024 "CLEAN BEACHES" PROGRAM



In parallel with the environmental approach of Tanger Med Group, the Foundation has been managing Dalia Beach since 2015 as part of the national "Clean Beaches" program initiated by the Mohammed VI Foundation for Environmental Protection.

Tanger Med Foundation provides funding as well as the logistical support and supervision necessary for the smooth running of this program. By providing facilities and equipment on the beach but also by upgrading the Dalia village socioeconomically and environmentally.

The program's facilities include walkways, sanitary facilities, furniture, entertainment, sports and leisure areas, a library, and a special system to assist individuals with reduced mobility.

For 2024, several new features have been implemented, including an animal biodiversity area in order to promote the culture of preservation of fauna and flora as well as the inauguration of a maritime exhibition, intended to help people discover and appreciate the oceans and their ecosystems.

The exhibition offered educational and educational activities including an aquarium presenting local marine biodiversity, scientific research workshops for children, and demonstrations on the recycling of fishing nets.

A digital library space has also been created, offering books in French, Arabic, and English, intended for both children and adults.

TANGER MED FOUNDATION MOBILIZED FOR THE HEALTH OF LOCAL RESIDENTS: CATARACT PROGRAM AND AMO SUPPORT



CONTINUED CATARACT AND RETINOPATHY SURGERY IN THE RURAL REGION OF FAHS-ANJRA

Launched by Tanger Med Foundation at the end of 2023, the operation to detect and treat cataracts and retinopathy is actively continuing in the Fahs-Anjra region, in northern Morocco. This initiative aims to combat visual disorders, particularly common in rural areas where access to health care is limited.

To date, 121 people have undergone surgery, restoring their vision and making their lives more comfortable. This success was possible thanks to the mobilization of associative and medical teams and the support of local authorities.

In a new phase, Tanger Med Foundation has also launched a program to treat people suffering from retinopathy, a common eye condition in rural areas exposed to extreme weather conditions, such as high exposure to the sun and wind. This condition can interfere with vision and cause significant discomfort if left untreated. It is particularly widespread in Fahs-Anjra, affecting mainly elderly people.

The objective of the Foundation is to continue to provide care, raise awareness among the local population and ultimately improve the quality of life of the inhabitants of Fahs-Anjra, with an emphasis on the most vulnerable people and the most remote areas.

COMPULSORY HEALTH INSURANCE (AMO):

As part of the program "Cataract and retinopathy surgery for the population of Fahs Anjra", recipients who do not have social security coverage, or whose right of access is suspended, often face difficulties in accessing care.

For this reason, Tanger Med Foundation decided to support them in the necessary steps to obtain or reactivate their AMO before proceeding with the operation. This support includes the identification of patients without coverage, referral to the relevant services, administrative assistance in completing documents, as well as awareness-raising actions on the importance of AMO.

Partnerships with local authorities and local associations have been essential to facilitate this process. By planning these procedures in advance and by setting up a continuous assistance program, Tanger Med Foundation wishes to facilitate sustainable access to social security coverage for people living in rural areas in order to establish better long-term social security.

DISTRIBUTION OF TEXTBOOKS AND SCHOOL SUPPLIES FOR THE 2024-2025 SCHOOL YEAR IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MDIQ-FNIDEQ



Two young athletes from the Dalia Association, Samy and Hatim, represented Morocco in the Optimist category during the Benghazi 2024 International Sailing Championship, which took place from August 10-13 in Libya, alongside competitors from countries such as Libya, Tunisia, Iraq, Seychelles, and Sudan. The Moroccan national team also participated in the ILCA 7 and Kite Surf categories.

This championship was part of the activities of the Benghazi Summer Festival 2024, an event that highlights water sports in Libya and served as a preparation for the African Championship to be organized in 2026.

To help disadvantaged families get back to school, Tanger Med Foundation took part in the 9th annual distribution of textbooks and school supplies in the Mdiq-Fnideq municipality. This initiative was carried out in collaboration with the Regional Education Delegation and the Association of Former Students of Fkih Daoud High School.

This operation aims to support 400 students, mainly middle and high school students who are orphans or come from disadvantaged families. It thus contributes to reducing social disparities and making education more accessible, by directly responding to the needs of the most disadvantaged students.

PLASTIC SEA: A DOCUMENTARY TO RAISE AWARENESS ABOUT THE DANGERS OF PLASTIC

This initiative aims to increase public awareness of the dangers of plastic while providing young people with an enriching and educational experience.

Among the 40 participants, Ouafi Yassine brilliantly took first place among the boys, while Wiam Dawdawi triumphed among the girls, underlining the promising talent of the team members.

THE FOUNDATION HAS LAUNCHED THE 2ND EDITION OF THE TRAINING PROGRAM FOR SUPPORT TEACHERS OF SPECIAL NEEDS STUDENTS (STSNS) IN



As part of its commitment to better inclusion of people with intellectual disabilities, Tanger Med Foundation renewed its partnership with the Enfants du Paradis Association and the Provincial Directorates of the Ministries of National Education and Health in Tangier in 2024. This partnership allowed the launch of the 3rd edition of the School Life Assistants (AVS) training program, dedicated to the inclusion and development of children with specific needs.

To celebrate the culmination of this initiative in favor of better social and academic inclusion, a certification ceremony took place on July 17th at the Association's headquarters. The event was attended by the Tanger Med Foundation team, members of the Association Enfants du Paradis, and trainers from a variety of backgrounds, and honored the 16 graduates of the training program.

This initiative highlights the importance of AVS training to effectively support children with disabilities, thus promoting their integration into the school environment.

STRENGTHENING OF WASTE COLLECTION EQUIPMENT IN THE TOWN OF JOUAMMAA

As part of its commitment to facilitate access to basic infrastructures in its areas of intervention, Tanger Med Foundation, in collaboration with Tanger Med Utilities, recently equipped the town of Jouammaa with 20 dumpsters, thus benefiting 200 households.

This major cultural event took place on board the world's first museum-boat and extends over the docks of the host cities (Malaga, Tangier, Rabat, Marseille, Venice, and Valletta). Visitors had the opportunity to participate in a multitude of artistic activities: a lively festival village throughout the day and until late in the evening, exhibition pavilions presenting works of photography and sculpture, as well as a virtual reality experience and a space dedicated to children with free access to games.

The museum boat, the main attraction of the festival, offers two innovative experiences: one immersive exhibition in collaboration with the Louvre Museum and a sound journey in the Mediterranean created by the Institute for Research and Coordination Acoustic/Music, in partnership with the Pompidou Center. THE LYMED SELECTION EXAMS: FIRST STEP TOWARDS EXCELLENCE



The selection exams took place successfully this year, bringing together a large number of candidates, all motivated to join LYMED. More than 70 000 candidates have applied for LYMED on the E-CPGE platform, testifying to the ever-growing appeal of LYMED.

After an initial selection on file, 807 candidates were invited for the selection exams, a number that illustrates the selectivity of LYMED very well.

This year's selection exams took place in three stages: a written test in mathematics, followed by an oral exam in physics, and concluded by a motivational interview. This process made it possible to measure both the academic skills and the communication skills of the candidates, offering a comprehensive assessment of their potential.

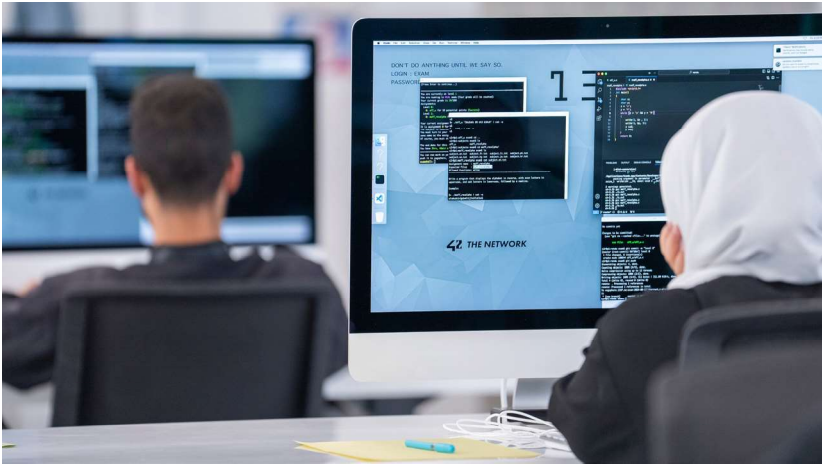
